Maths

The children will be studying how to write and describe a addition or subtraction number sentence. The children will start to look at the 10 times table and use number facts to aid in the addition and subtraction in 10s. Maths fluency will also take place for all Year 1/2 children three times a week.

Music

In Music, the children will be preparing for the Christmas performance. They will also compose their own piece of music and perform it. Singing will also take place in a weekly singing assembly.

History

This half-term, Year 1/2 will be investigating the history of polar exploration. They will learn about Ernest Shackleton and create a timeline of key events

of his life. The children will compare modern polar exploration equipment to that used in the time of Shackleton.



<u>R.E</u>

This half term, the children will be about the Christian festival of Christmas. They will study its importance to Christians, and how we celebrate it. As part of the topic 'Polar Explorer', the children will be studying textiles in preparation to make a warm, comfy jacket for an explorer's teddy bear.
